Who can go?

All Explorer Scouts aged 16 on August 15th 2009 and members of the Scout Network from any unit/group across the County.

What is it?

- To plan and train for an international expedition as part of a small team
- To travel to another country of their choice and travel through that country over ten days
- To complete a major project of their own choice
- To complete around ten smaller projects
- To keep a notebook or diary during the expedition
- To take part in a debriefing after the expedition
- To make a presentation about the expedition
- You will be working as a small team, typically four people
